<u>Concerts</u>~ Concert Choir is designed to spark an appreciation of vocal music in those that enjoy singing. This course will teach vocal singing and pedagogy, sight singing, performance techniques and improve singing ability. The class is required to attend 3 concerts to showcase their singing ability.

Grades are calculated using total points system.

Students are expected to arrive on time to class with a pencil and a folder. They are to be in their seat by the time the bell rings or points will be deducted from their grade. Any horseplay or constant off task incidents and the student's grade will be lowered.
