Emotional Support Program

MIU IV's Emotional Support program is designed for students with significant emotional support needs who have problems functioning in a public school classroom. After a referral is made by a school district, MIU IV reviews all student information and, if appropriate, designs a program to meet the students' needs. Once enrolled in the program, students receive individual or small group academic instruction in a self-contained site; a monthly psychiatric consultation if needed; and extensive support services and community-based instruction.

All MIU #4 staff are trained in nonviolent crisis intervention and safety care techniques
